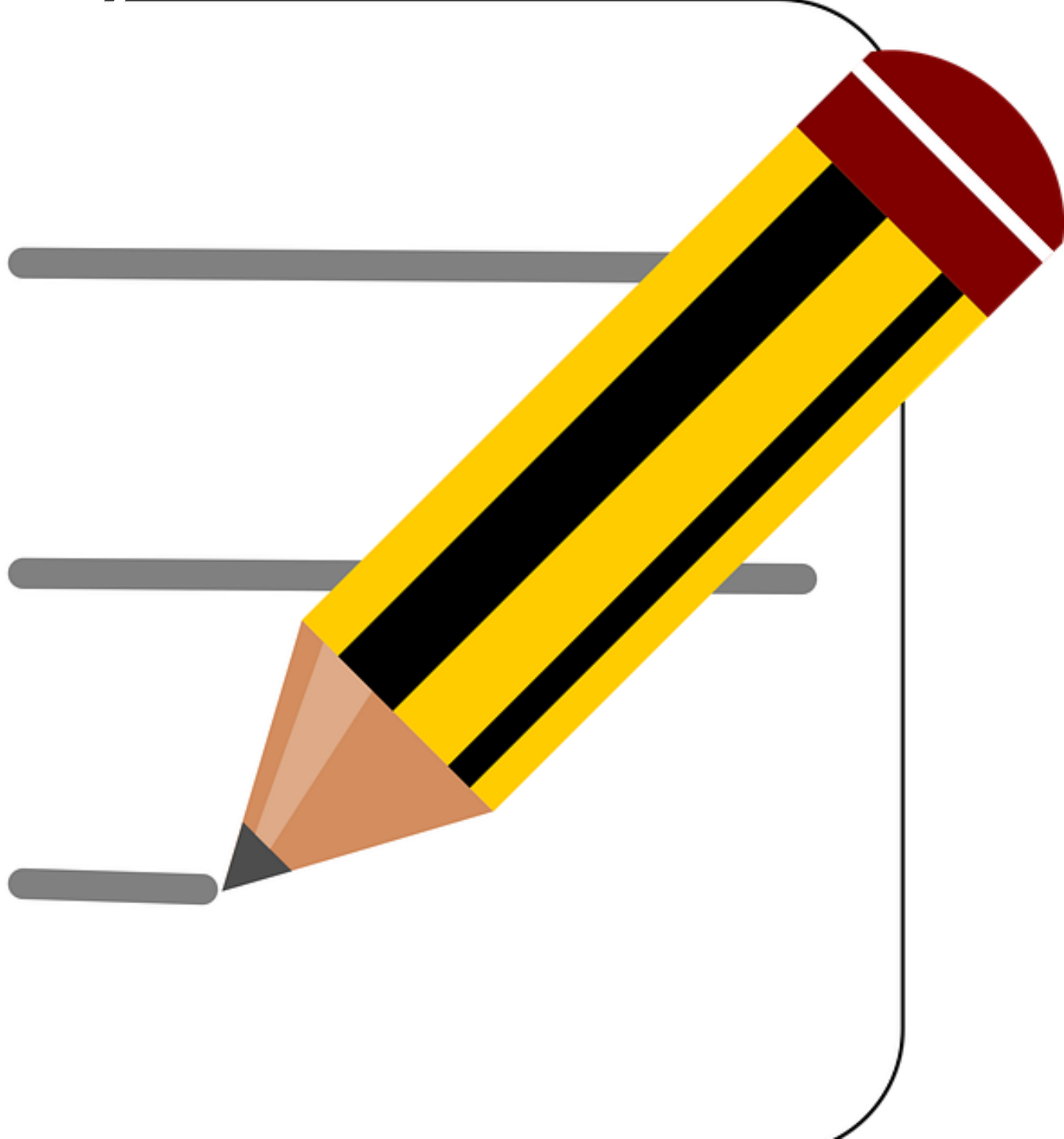

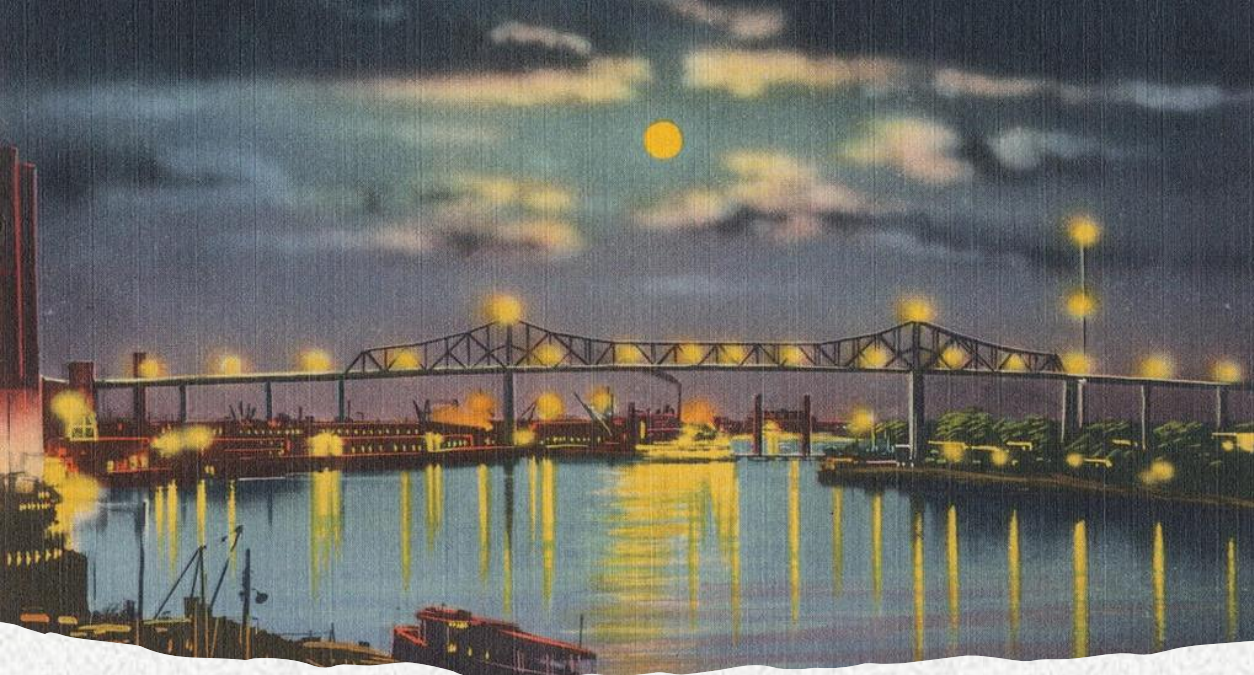

- **Success Criteria:**
 - 50 words exactly

Postcard from a book character...

- Write a postcard to Ms Hanson and Ms Lee from a book character on an adventure
- Success Criteria: address and message on one side, picture on the other; message must be from a known book character; picture must illustrate the adventure; it must be signed off 'from (name of book character)' E.g. 'from Harry' if you wrote it from Harry Potter
- Address the card to: Ms Hanson and Ms Lee, AISHK Library, 3A Norfolk Road, Kowloon Tong, Hong Kong
- Deadline: Friday, week 4 (22 August); hand in to Library
- PRIZES: 50 house points for all entries; Year7/8 winner café vouchers; 9/10 café vouchers; 11/12 café vouchers

Create an artwork...

- Create an artwork: model, painting or drawing
- The theme of the artwork is 'Adventure'
- Success Criteria: communicates theme of adventure in some way, demonstrates originality, interesting use of materials
- Deadline: Friday, week 4 (22 August)
- PRIZES: book voucher (7/8 winner, 9/10 winner, 11/12 winner)



Fun Friday Obstacle Course

- Race round the course, manoeuvring round objects and solving clues
- Sign up outside of the Library (notice board) – minimum of 3, maximum of 6
